



**Directions to Woodcraft School: Site Grid Reference: SU 86276 27491**  
**Post code for Sat Nav: GU30 7NF**

By road- from A3 -take the Liphook turnoff and drive through the town until you reach a series of 3 very mini roundabouts. Take the left hand exit at the first two (they are very close together) and at the third roundabout take the second exit. If you look up high you will see signs to Midhurst –you should be travelling on the ‘Midhurst Road’ and heading towards Redford. At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit (excluding entrance to Sainsbury) and follow signs towards the train station but do not turn right off this road towards the train station but carry on over a railway bridge. Follow this for about 2 miles through woodland and past a big country house until you get to a signposted left hand turn towards Midhurst, Woolbeding and Redford and turn onto Linch Road (ignore the first one to Fernhurst). Follow this for about 1/5 mile -as the road bends you will see a church on the right (Linch Church) - immediately on the bend on the left hand side is the turning into our car park. You will also find this gateway located between the two houses called Linchgate House and The Old Cottage. Please look for our signs at the entrance to the gate.

#### **From Midhurst:**

From the A272 from Petworth towards Midhurst. Go up Midhurst High Street and take turning towards Petersfield on the A272 at the roundabout. Carry on for just under a mile and you will pass the Half Moon pub on your right. Do not take the turning into June Lane but take the next turning right signposted to Woolbeding (if you see go past a Gallery on your left, you have gone too far). Go over the river and keep on this road until you come to a large house and farmyard on the corner (called Woolbeding Farm). Follow road round sharp to the left towards Liphook–do not go straight on! Follow this road heading for Liphook/ Redford –note part of it is a very winding narrow lane with few passing places. Stay on this road. You will come to Redford village and the village garage is on the left hand side. Carry on through the village and through a bit of woodland until you reach a straight bit of road and at the end on the right hand side is a gateway located between the two houses called Lynchgate House and The Old Cottage.
